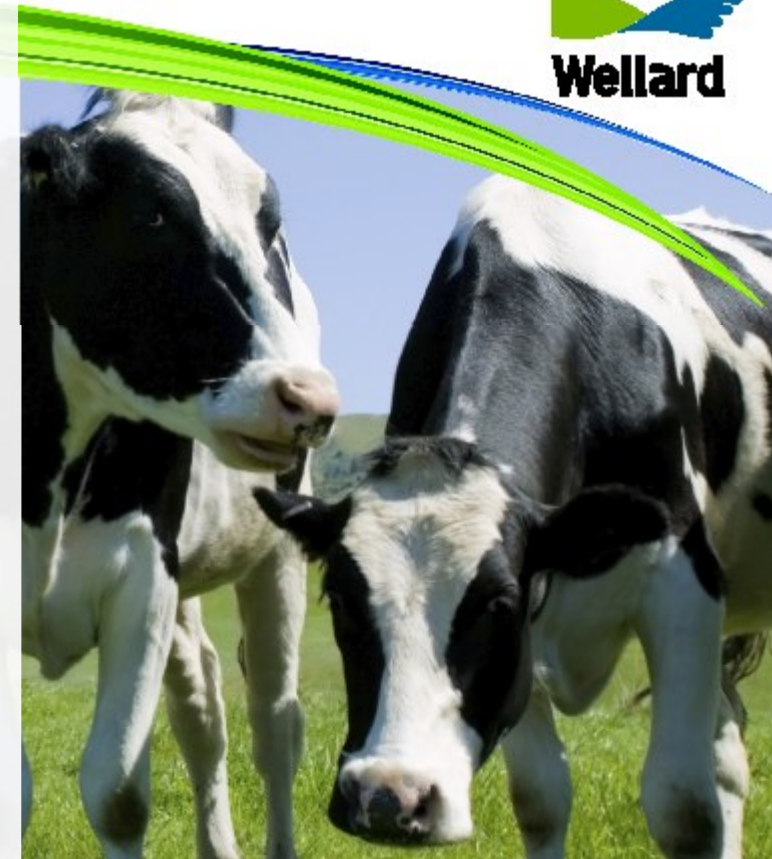

Jersey

Jersey cows originally came from the Island of Jersey in the English Channel. They became established as a breed in Australia in the late 1800's. Jerseys are small grey or fawn cows with quiet natures. Their milk is very rich in butterfat, so it is good for making butter. They make up 21% of Australia's dairy cattle.

Friesian

Holstein Friesians are a combination of two types of cow. Friesian cows were originally from Friesland in Holland and first arrived in Australia in the 1850's. These big cows are black and white and produce a high volume of milk. As farmers are often paid on the amount of milk they produce, Holstein Friesians are quite popular, making up more than 60% of Australia's dairy cattle. They can cope with a broad range of temperatures and conditions.

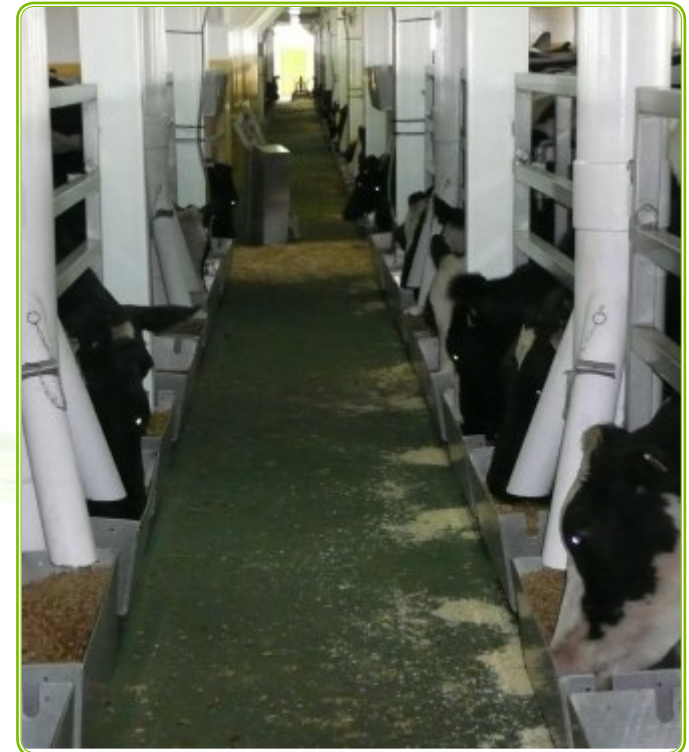
